Did you know, in Pennsylvania...

Nearly 202,000 children live in households headed by grandparents or other relatives

More than 80,000 grandparents are responsible for meeting the basic needs of their grandchildren

Grandparents and other relative and non-relative caregivers help children thrive by keeping them loved, safe, and situated in communities known to them

However, those that provide kinship care...

May not be aware of the resources available to help them

May become financially and emotionally stressed by their new roles

May not know their legal rights and responsibilities

May struggle to balance what is best for the children they are raising and what is best for themselves
